In the years 1570 - 1583 Clares have a plan of 18, the role of the cornfields, 135 the role of land, 28 acres of forest parsonic. The village was a bridge Nuns, Nuns Forest. The monastery served as a warehouse for the Swedes. The monastery has undergone dissolution.
